



# WHAT YOU NEED

## **Compound Archery**

- Bow: Durable frame (1,5 to 2,5 Kg), cams for mechanical assistance, let-off for easier draw holding
- Sight & Scope: Adjustable sight with magnification for precise aiming.
- Release Aid & D-Loop: Replaces finger shooting; ensures consistent and smooth releases.
- Stabilizers & Dampeners: For balance and reduced vibration.
- Arrow Rest: Fall-away or blade rest for stability during the shot.

#### **Recurve Archery**

Recurve archery emphasizes consistency and form, with simpler mechanics compared to compound archery. There is no use of cams, release aids and scopes for precision and ease.

#### Arrow

- Carbon or aluminum-carbon composite, tailored in length and spine (Length: 66 -81 cm, Weight: 16 - 32 g)
- Precision nocks, screw-in or glue-in points, and fletching for stability.

## The Outfit

Archers wear fitted clothes to avoide obstructions and ensure freedom of movement. Some archers wear arm & chest guards to protect them from string contact.
