

WHAT YOU NEED

Volleyball

- A high-quality volleyball is made of synthetic or genuine leather with an inner bladder. It must have a circumference of 65–67 cm (25.5–26.4 inches) and weigh 260–280 g (9.2–9.9 oz).

Net

- The net is tightly stretched across the court and supported by two poles. It must be 2.43 m (7 ft 11.6 in) high for men and 2.24 m (7 ft 4.1 in) high for women, with a width of 9.5–10 m (31.2–32.8 ft) and 10 cm (3.9 in) mesh squares

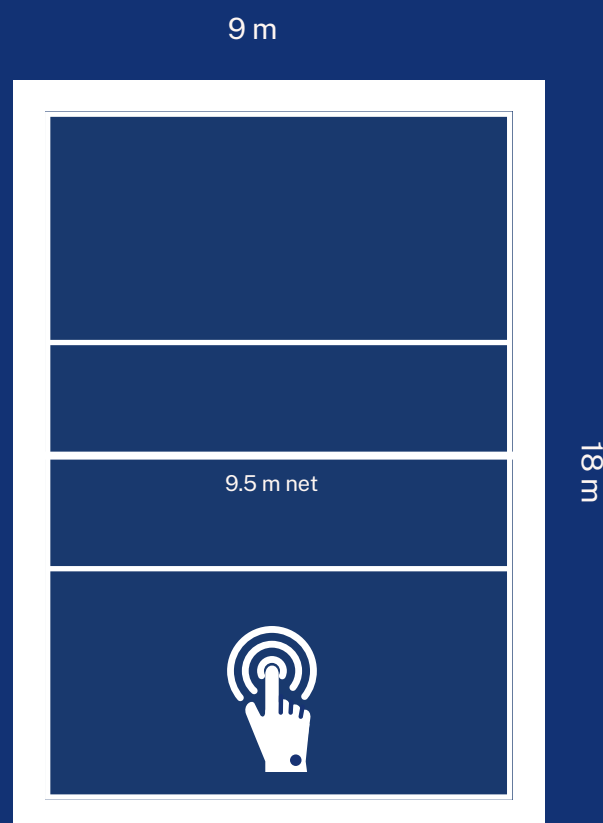
Court

- The volleyball court measures 18 m × 9 m (59 ft × 29.5 ft) and has a 3 m (9.8 ft) attack line on each side. It must have a smooth, non-slip surface, typically made of wood or synthetic material.

Player Equipment

- Players wear jerseys with numbers (1–20), shorts, and non-marking shoes. Knee pads protect against falls, and the libero wears a distinct jersey color.
